The Plot

In director Andrew Stanton's computeranimated hit movie, a lonely robot named Wall-E (Ben Burtt), who was left to clean up the Earth after humans abandon it, falls in love with a bewitching research probe, Eve (Elissa Knight), who drops down to the planet in a spaceship, looking for signs of life.

Our Insider

Gian Gonzaga is a senior research scientist at eHarmony, the popular online dating service that matches people based on key personality traits. Gonzaga, who married in June, met his wife in a UCLA psychology lab studying marriage. He is currently leading a study on interpersonal chemistry.

DOVERVIEW "One of the most fundamental drives we have as humans is to connect to other people. In the film, Pixar does an amazing job of using robots to reflect the reality of human emotion. We identify with Wall-E and Eve because humans fall in love in the same ways."

▶ SIMILARITIES ATTRACT "On the surface, Wall-E and Eve appear to be opposites. [He's boxy and battered; she's sleek and high-tech.] But deep down, they share important charac-

teristics. They're conscientious about duty, have similar reactions to things, and they're protective. Caregiving is crucial in long-term relationships. We need someone to help us through the hard times. There's a scene where Eve goes into a deactivated state, and Wall-E protects her. It's analogous to a person being in the hospital. Later, at the space station, when Wall-E is broken and falling apart, Eve takes him back to Earth to find replacement parts and fixes him."

A CONNECTION "Halfway through the movie, Wall-E and Eve touch heads, and there's an actual spark. Touch is [essential] to human relationships; it sets off a cascade of hormones that causes individuals to bond. Obviously, in robot world, hormones don't exist, but the scene suggests chemistry. At eHarmony, we have been studying what causes that 'spark.'"

PATIENCE "All relationships take time. That's one of the movie's themes. In the beginning, it's not so obvious that Wall-E and Eve's relationship is actually going to occur. Wall-E pursues Eve, but she's not too sure about him. Everyone has to answer for themselves when they think they've put enough effort into a relationship and they're not getting something back. Don't bail right away, but know what your tolerance level is."
